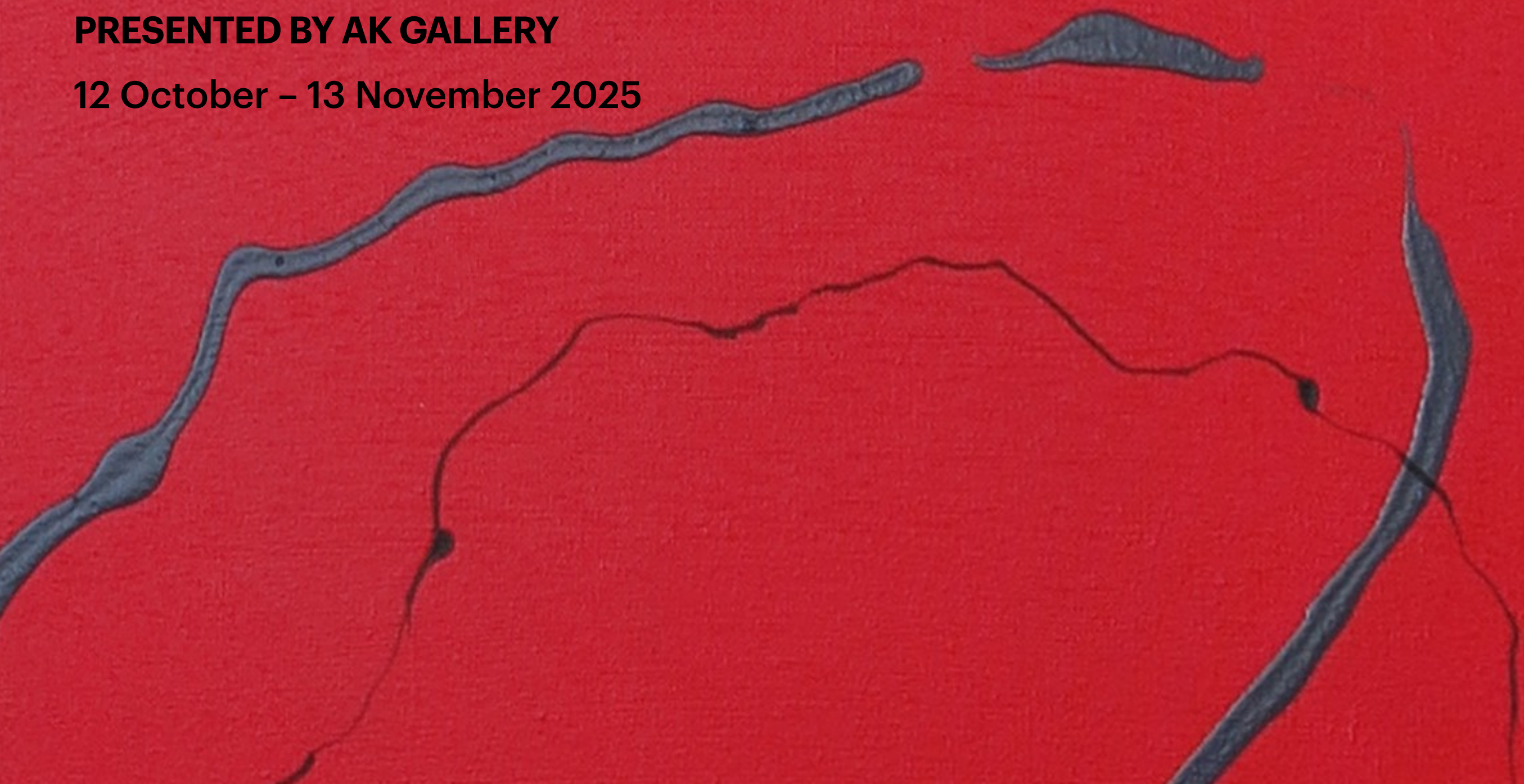

ALBERT MERZ

Albert Merz was born in Switzerland in 1942. He trained as an educator and taught art at various high schools. In 1980, he decided to study at the University of the Arts in Berlin under Professor Horst Hirsig. During the era of the *Junge Wilde*, Merz quickly gained recognition in galleries across Europe. His works have been exhibited in Berlin, Hamburg, Munich, Kassel, Paris, Vienna, and Zurich, among other cities. He continues to live and work in Berlin today.







Clear pictures, yet full of secrets. Is that a paradox?

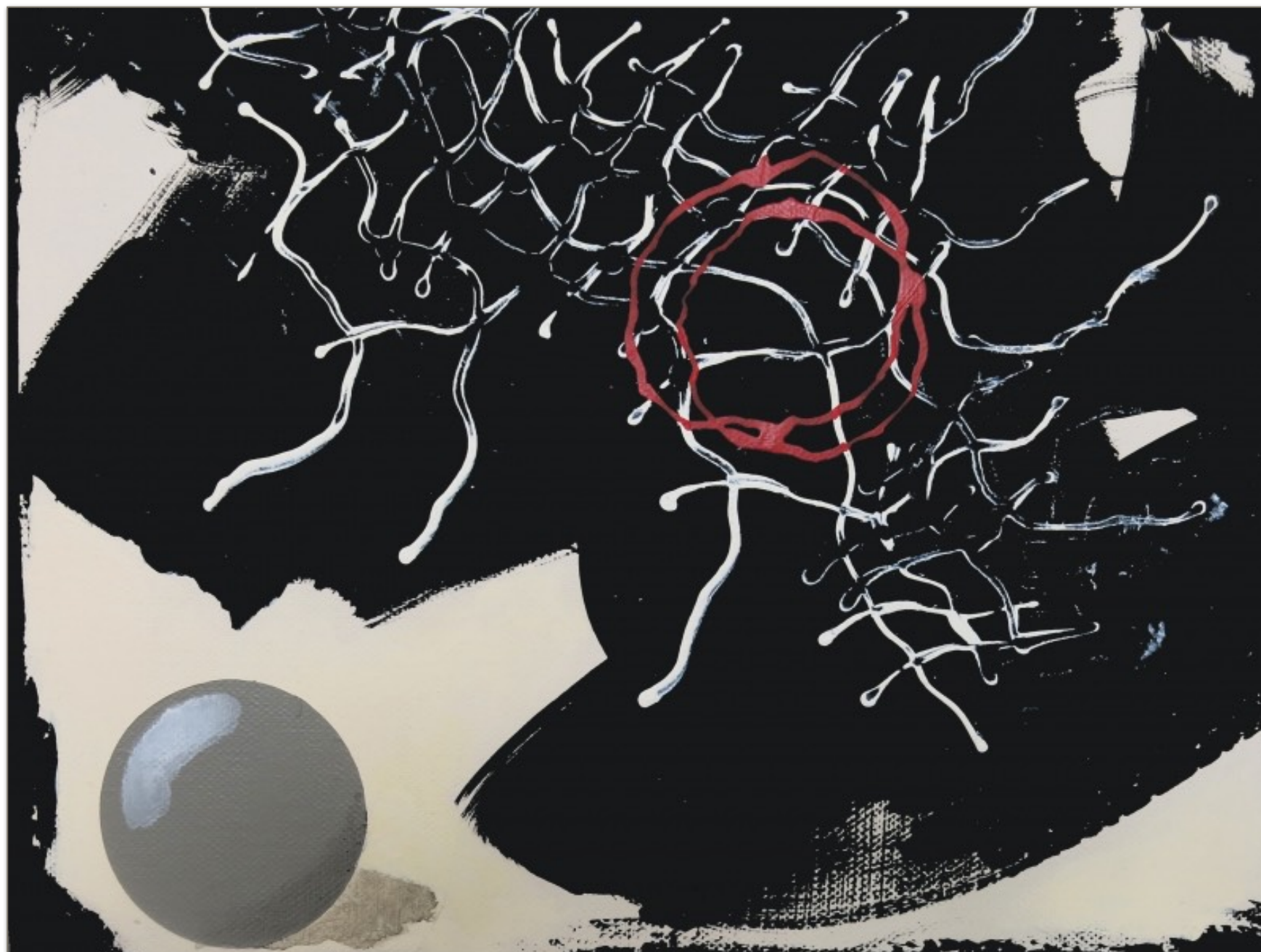
Merz came late to art, after years of personal restriction. He moved from Switzerland to Berlin in 1980, looking for freer grounds and for a vision where opposites would complement each other rather than conflict. His practice has often blurred the borders between figuration and abstraction, intellectual depth and sensuality, mystery and irony – aligning him with the *Junge Wilde*.

The first exhibition of the artist at AK Galerie, *INTRO* shows Merz at his present best. Age has gifted him with the quietest introspective gaze, whereas his language is now surprisingly extroverted. He distils snapshots of his inner world with unprecedented spontaneity and clarity.

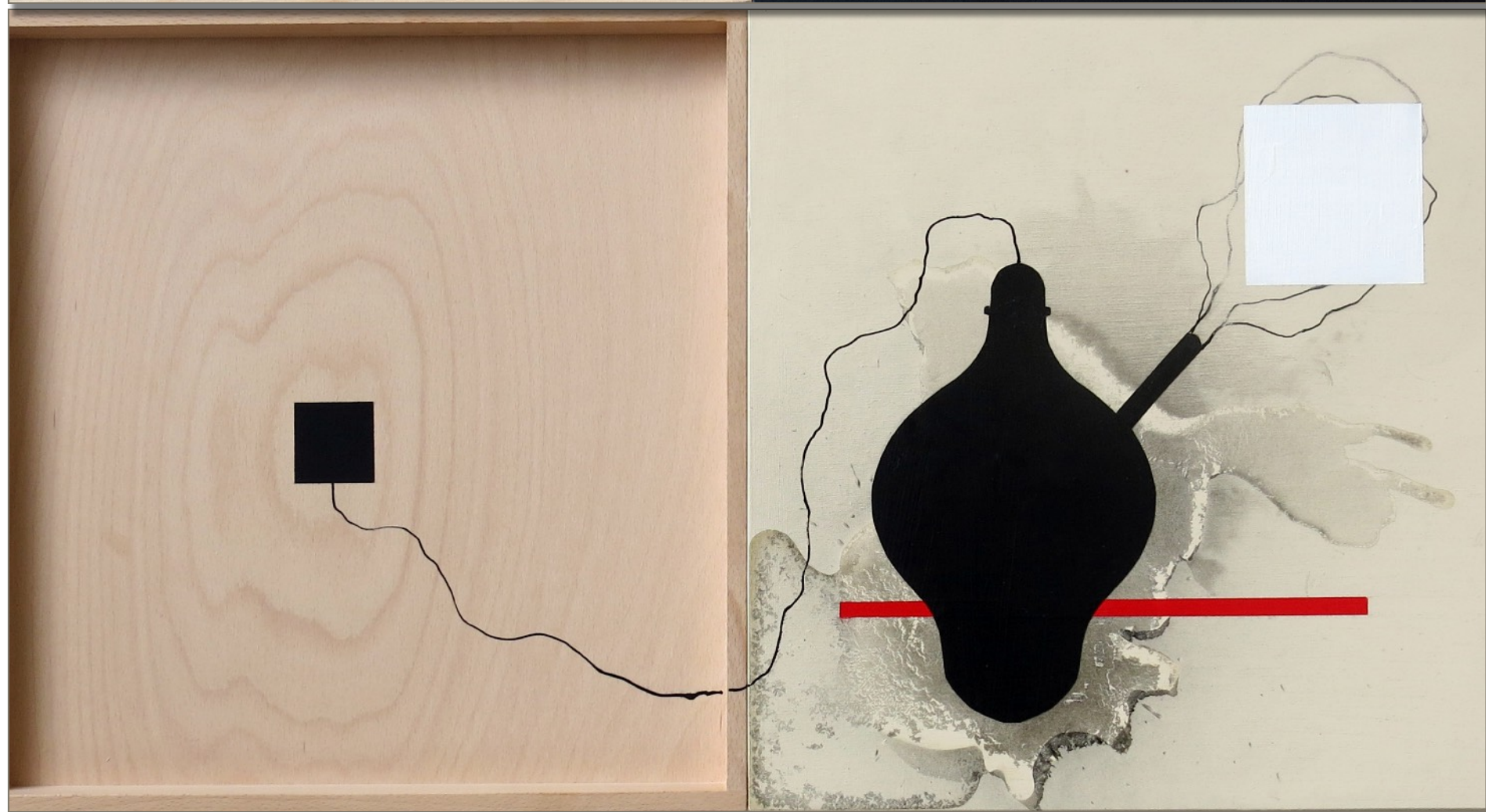

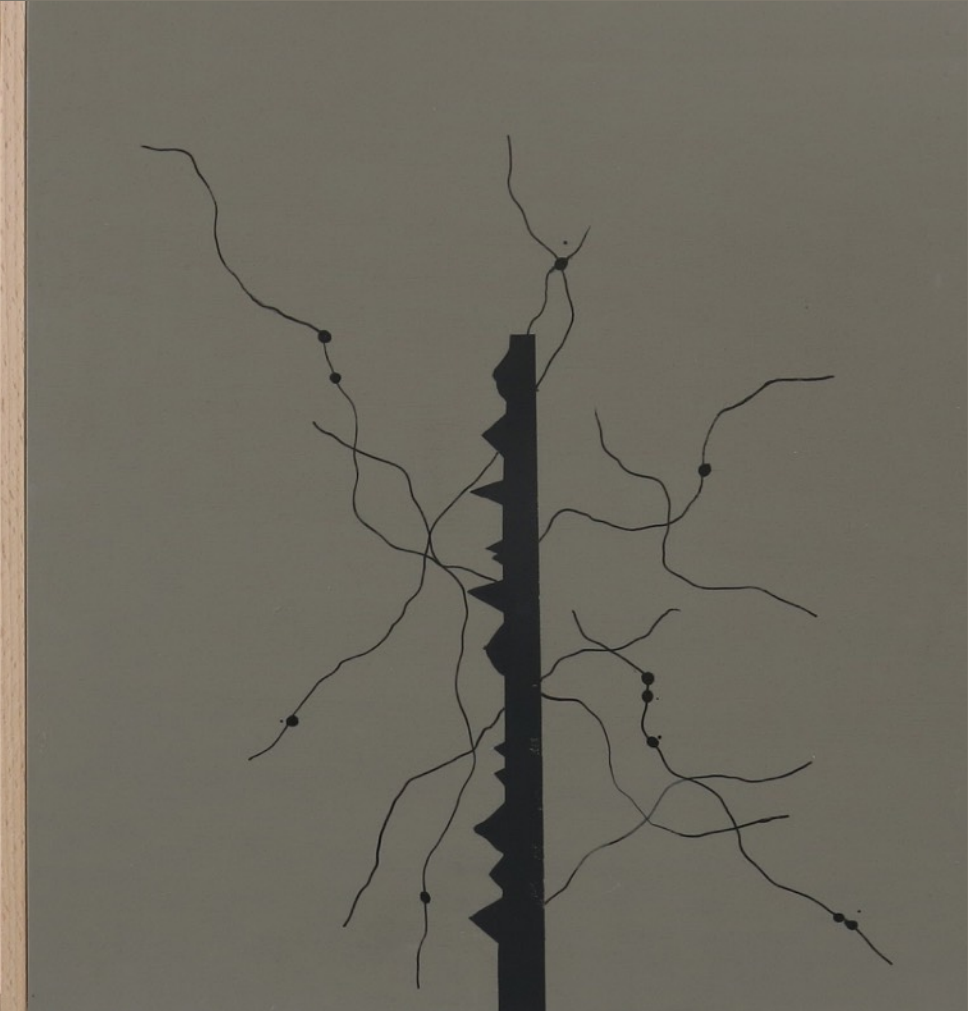
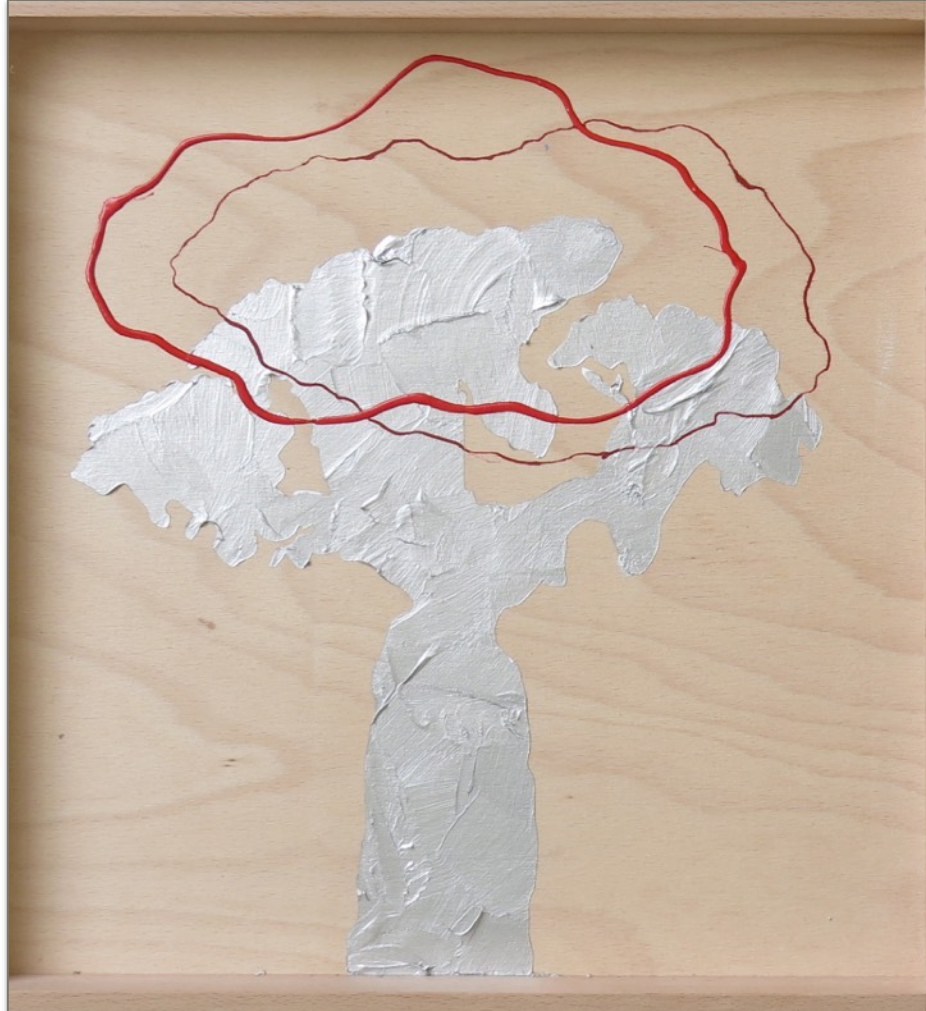
CAPRICE 13,

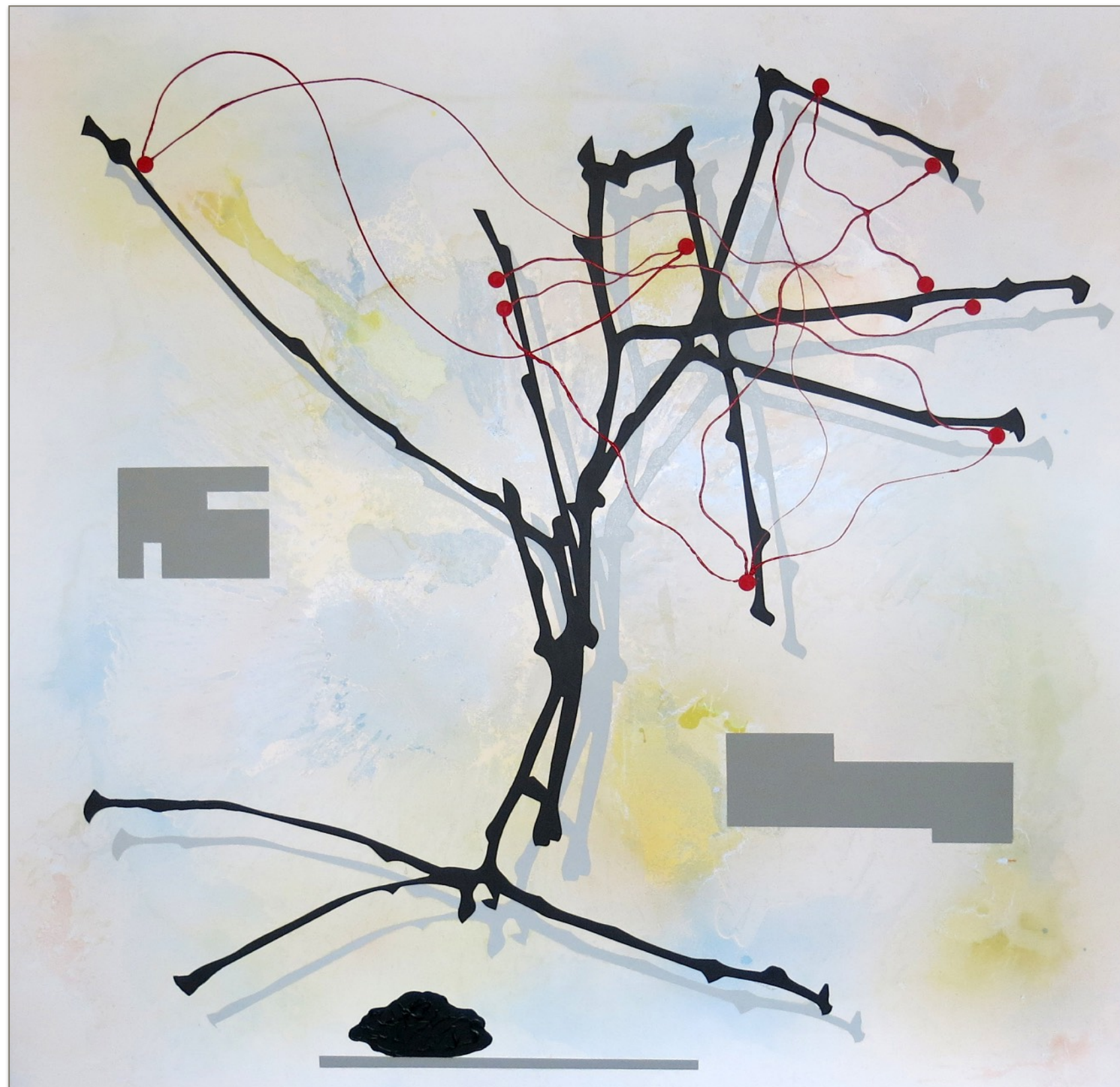


CAPRICE 67,

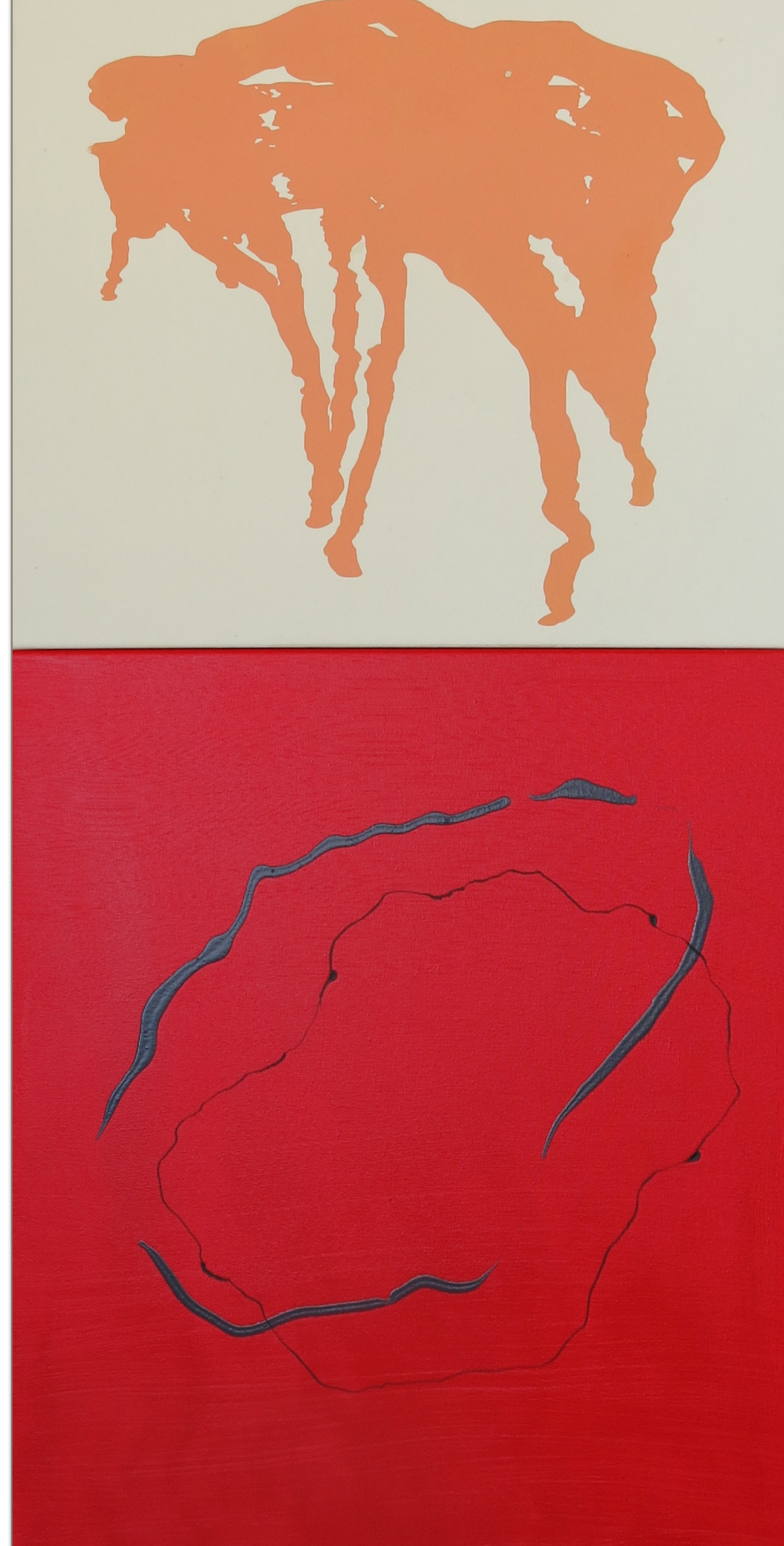

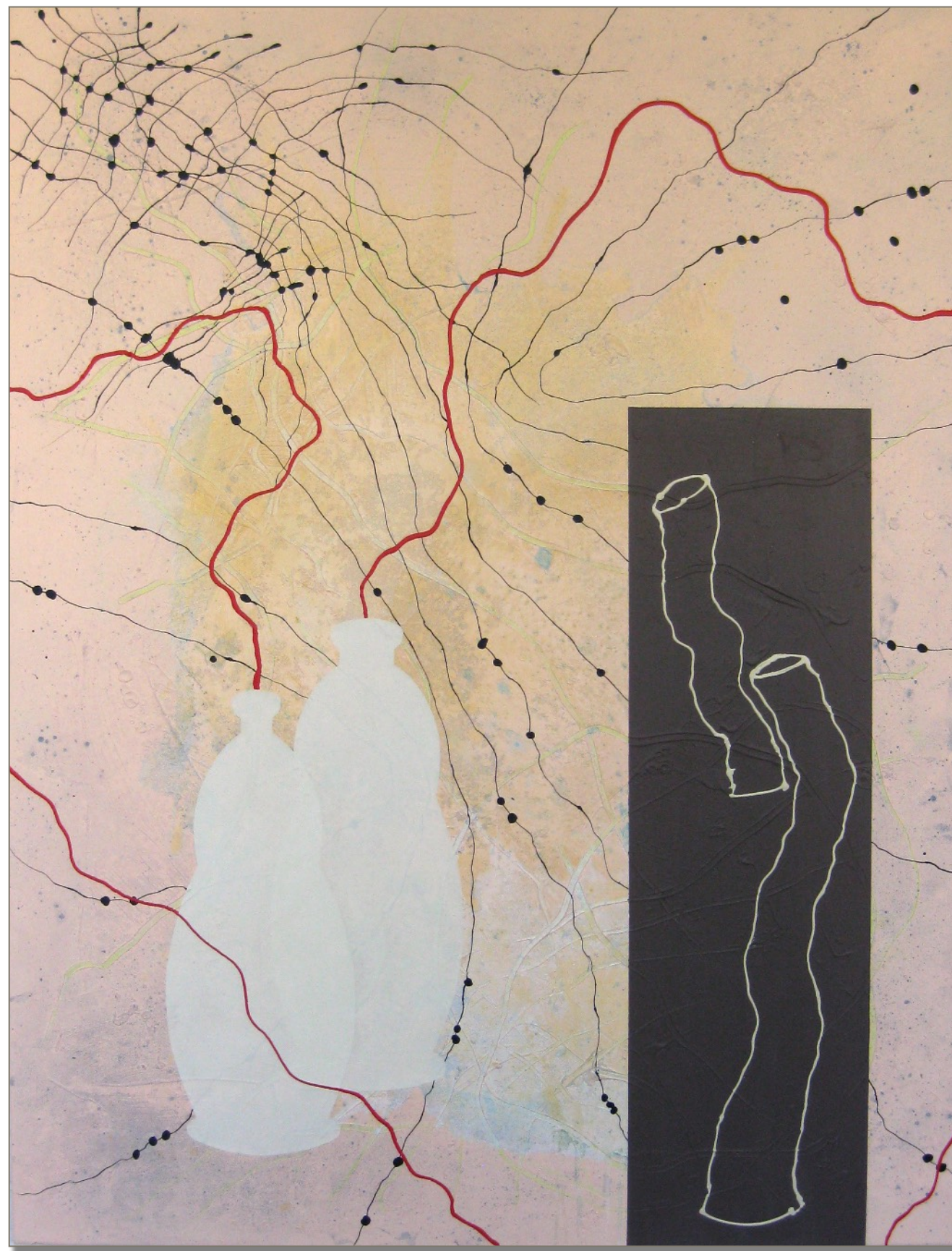
